Health & Wellness ½ credit (4 quarters)	Health classes are scheduled during elective period. Students are required to participate in health and wellness courses for 1 quarter each year.			
Metacognition ½ credit (4 quarters)	Metacognition classes are scheduled during elective period. Community Service* ½ credit (4 quarters)	Community service classes are designed to provide opportunities for Centreville Layton Upper School students to serve the school community as well as broader community through volunteerism. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades 11-12 students are required to complete 40 additional hours of targeted community service 			
Electives 1½ credit (12 quarters)	Electives are designed to provide breadth to the academic program for Centreville Layton Upper School students. Students are required to earn credits in these areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visual Arts-1/2 credit (painting, drawing, film criticism, film production, yearbook, web design, etc.) Performance Arts-1/2 credit (vocal/instrumental music, theatre, public speaking, primitive tools, go-karts, etc.)-Other elective courses may be offered.
